Narrative Title: Narrative

BWC Recording

On the morning of March 2, 2024, patrol deputies responded to two different public parks in Deltona in reference to the reports of vehicle burglaries. Detective Richardson was assigned the cases for further investigation and follow-up. The victims and case specifics are listed below, and all the cases will be investigated and documented under one master case number 240004634. Detective Richardson determined it was the same suspect vehicle captured on multiple surveillance footage videos provided by a City of Deltona Parks and Recreation employee and independent witness in the area of Vann Park based on the vehicle's color, make, model, and dark tinted windows.

The following victims reported their vehicle's being burglarized and personal property being stolen from 1190 Saxon Blvd, (Dewey Boster Park), Deltona at approximately 1111 hours, on March 2, 2024, under VSO case number 240004634.

Black Subaru bearing FL tag: AJ28AC, attempted entry to the front driver window, gained access by shattering the rear driver side window. Blessing Ball (V1) advised her brown leather clutch with gold brass brine stones on it (\$50) was located in the front of the vehicle and was taken. Blessing explained inside the clutch was a red leather wallet (\$50) containing credit cards, debit cards, health insurance cards, miscellaneous cards, driver's license, and \$250 in US Currency. Blessing said the total value of her stolen items was approximately \$350. Blessing stated the estimated cost to repair her windows was around \$500. Blessing completed a sworn written statement and advised she wished to pursue criminal charges. Blessing also invoked Marsy's Law, wishing to keep her information private.

Silver Acura bearing FL tag: QFMP82, gained access by shattering the rear passenger window. Gina Gonzalez Aponte (V2) advised her black purse with pink flowers and the words "DomRep" on it (\$40), was taken from inside the vehicle. Inside the purse was \$70 in cash, her driver's license, Venture Master Card ending in *9163, as well as miscellaneous cosmetics (\$25). Gina stated the total value of her stolen items was approximately \$135. Gina said the estimated damage to her vehicle was around \$300. Gina completed a sworn written statement and advised she wished to pursue criminal charges. Gina also invoked Marsy's Law, wishing to keep her information private.

Blue Infiniti bearing FL tag: GHGG96, gained access by shattering the rear driver side window. Carwin Bleidt (V3) advised a blue purse (\$100), car keys (\$10), credit card, and debit card, were taken from his vehicle. Carwin stated the total value of his stolen property was approximately \$110. Carwin said the approximate damage to his vehicle was around \$300. Carwin completed a sworn written statement and advised he wished to pursue criminal charges. Carwin also invoked Marsy's Law, wishing to keep his information private.

White Toyota bearing FL tag: EHBW18, gained access by shattering the front passenger window. Lauren Platt (V4) advised a black Kate Spade cross body style purse (\$50), blue Steve Madden card wallet (\$30), blue Michael Khor's wallet (\$10), three credit cards, Bank of America debit card, and personal cards were taken from her vehicle. Lauren stated the total value of her stolen property was approximately \$90. Lauren said the approximate damage to his vehicle was around \$300. Lauren completed a sworn written statement and advised she wished to pursue criminal charges. Lauren also invoked Marsy's Law wishing to keep her information private.

The other two victims reported their vehicles were burglarized and had property stolen from 675 Elgrove Drive (Vann Park), Deltona, on March 2, 2024, at approximately 1112 hours, under VSO case number 240004635.

Silver Ford bearing FL tag: ITWL57; attempted entry to the passenger front window, gained access by shattering the rear passenger side window. Upon arrival, Deputy Metz made contact with Terri L Ellis (V5) who advised she arrived at Vann Park around 10:30 hours for a garden club meeting. Around 11:20 hours, a friend informed her that her passenger rear window was broken out, and there was a crack in the passenger front window. Terri advised several items were taken from her vehicle. Terri advised her black coach purse (\$199), Apple iPhone 13 (\$900), red wallet (\$60), her Florida Driver's License, Two Fairwinds Debit Cards, Two Capital One Credit Cards, \$500 worth of Mexican Pesos in US Currency, \$6.00 US Currency, prescription eyeglasses (\$320), a prescription bottle with 50 pills of Lorazepam (\$40), Medical Insurance ID Card, and Kohls Credit Card. Terri said all of the items were located in her purse which was on the floor of the vehicle behind the passenger seat. Terri stated the total value of her stolen property was approximately \$2,019. Terri was unable to provide further bank information as she did not have access to her phone and was unable to make contact with her husband. Terri advised the damage to the front passenger window, which was not completely broken and would cost around \$600 to repair. Terri stated

she wishes to pursue charges at this time. Terri completed and signed a sworn written statement.

Gray Ford bearing FL tag: 456RTR; vehicle left unlocked. The victim Jacqueline Almonte (V6) advised she came to Vann Park for a meeting at 10am. Around 11:10 she was told someone's car window was broken. Jacqueline went to check her vehicle and observed it had been burglarized as her wallet was on the seat, rather than in the center console, and the glove box was open, which she never touched or altered. Jacqueline stated her vehicle was left unlocked. Jacqueline advised she saw what appeared to be a silver passenger car drive out of the park, possibly a Toyota. Jacqueline advised she wishes to pursue charges at this time. Jacqueline completed and signed a sworn written statement.

The VSO Crime Scene Unit was contacted and responded to the scenes and processed the vehicles for evidence and latent prints. Elimination prints were collected from the victims.

At approximately 1320 Hours, Almonte received a phone call from Ellis's stolen cell phone. A man, later identified as Louis D Castriota (O1), advised he found the phone on the ground while placing an open house sign. He found the phone at the intersection of Whitewood Drive and S Wellington Drive, in Deltona, approximately .2 miles from the incident. Castriota was at 1120 Gerona Avenue, for an open house he was performing. Deputies recovered and collected Terri's iPhone at 1120 Gerona Avenue and submitted it to evidence for processing.

Information was received the suspect vehicle may be a silver passenger vehicle with dark tinted windows was seen leaving Vann Park at a high rate of speed around the of the incidents.

Video surveillance footage was collected from 658 Elgrove Drive which is just over 300 feet away from the entrance and exit of Vann Park. In the video labeled 1_10.10.11, a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle description is seen driving toward the park at the 25:56 mark and then heading away from the park toward Whitewood Drive at the 32:02 mark.

Detective Richardson made contact with Mark Manning (O2), of Deltona Parks and Recreation who assisted with obtaining video surveillance footage of the entrance and inside Dewey Boster Park from March 2. Detective Richardson noted in both collected videos from near the entrance of Vann Park and Dewey Boster a newer model silver Nissan with very dark tinted windows was captured. The silver Nissan was seen entering Dewey Boster at approximately 1043 hours and leaving at approximately 1058 hours. The tag seen attached to the Nissan in the video was Florida tag PI101R which per DAVID and FCIC/NCIC was registered to Carl Black of Orlando located at 11500 E Colonial Drive, Orlando.

Using the online license plate database Detective Richardson queried the Florida tag attached to the Nissan (PI101R). Detective Richardson observed the tag was attached to a black GMC pickup truck with Carl Black company decals on the rear window in Seminole County on March 1, 2024, at approximately 1701 hours. The database showed on March 2, 2024, at approximately 1032 hours, the tag was seen attached to a silver Nissan passenger car with dark tinted windows entering Deltona on Saxon Blvd, then on Normandy Blvd in Deltona at approximately 1043 hours, and leaving Deltona on Saxon Blvd at approximately 1109 hours. The images of the silver Nissan with Florida tag PI101R were uploaded to Axon Evidence.

Detective Richardson made contact with Bob Yokes (O3) who is the rental and lease manager for Carl Black GMC. Bob was informed about the tag being switched from the black pickup to the silver Nissan. Bob stated there was no reason the tag should be on a silver Nissan passenger car. A short time later, Bob contacted Detective Richardson and advised he spoke with Kermith Rivera (O4) who the truck was currently rented to and was told the tag had been stolen off the truck at an apartment complex in Sanford. Bob forwarded Detective Richardson a photocopy of the online police report filed by Kermith to Sanford Police Department (Sanford Online Report Number T2400010) reporting the tag stolen on March 3, 2024.

On March 5, 2024, Detective Richardson received information that Blessing was attempting to reach him. Detective Richardson called Blessing who stated she was contacted by the Regions Bank located at 8061 Via Dellagio Way in Orlando on March 4, 2024, at approximately 1430 hours. Blessing advised she was informed that an unknown female had attempted to use her Florida Driver's License to cash a Synovus Bank check #1082 for \$1,000 via the bank's drive-thru lane. Blessing said the bank had retained the check and her driver's license. The female was seen driving a silver Nissan passenger car with tag believed to be CX4526.

Detective Richardson responded to the Regions Bank in Orlando and met with the teller Savitri Masih-Das (O5) who described the above incident. Savitri stated the female was acting very suspicious by attempting to conceal her identity in the drive-thru by looking away from the camera and wearing sunglasses. Savitri stated she asked the female to come into the bank to complete the transaction and to confirm her identity, but the female left the area. Savitri said she notified her supervisor Carmella Barbarino (O6) about the incident. Carmella provided the driver's license and check to Detective Richardson. Carmell and Savitri willingly provided elimination prints for comparison to the items.

Detective Richardson observed the Synovus Bank check # 1082 was issued to Theresa Bleidt Bell (O7). Detective Richardson noted Theresa shares the same last name as Carwin who reported his blue Infiniti bearing Florida tag: GHGG96, was burglarized at Dewey Boster Park on March 2, 2024. Detective determined this check was likely stolen from Carwin's vehicle during the vehicle burglaries.

All the collected items were later submitted into evidence via the District 4 Evidence Locker for processing.

Detective Richardson located a license plate reader camera in the immediate area (approximately 0.5 miles away) of the Regions Bank which the silver Nissan would have likely passed driving to or away from the location. Detective Richardson located the same newer model silver Nissan with very dark tinted windows and matching wheels was captured on the license plate reader traveling East toward Interstate 4 on March 4, 2024, at approximately 1454 hours. The tag reader image showed the silver Nissan had Florida tag CK4526 attached to it in the hit. The captured tag was only one character difference from the tag information provided by the bank staff. The tag

reader misread the tag on the silver Nissan as CK4S26, but the image is very clear, and the tag can be read as CK4526.

Detective Richardson ran the Florida tag CK4526 used the online drivers license and vehicle information database (DAVID) which showed the tag was assigned to a black 2018 Ram pickup truck out of Orlando.

Through investigative techniques by the Volusia County Crime Center the silver Nissan was observed and captured on a license plate reader camera in Seminole County on March 2, 2024, at approximately 0847 and 0908 hours at an intersection in very close proximity to the apartment complex where the Florida tag PI101R was reported stolen from off the black GMC pickup truck. This was the same date the vehicle burglaries occurred in Deltona and the silver Nissan was observed in Deltona on license plate reader cameras bearing Florida tag PI101R. The true tag assigned to the silver Nissan was identified as EVY127, registered to Sixt Rent A Car LLC.

The vehicle was entered into FCIC/NCIC as a felony vehicle with the assistance of the Volusia Sheriff's Office Teletype Operator Smola #8905.

Detective Richardson was notified by Deputy M. Jeffries of the Hardee County Sheriff's Office that he was in contact with the vehicle on a traffic stop based on the FCIC/NCIC entry. Deputy Jeffries stated the vehicle was occupied by two males identified as Joshua Hansen (S1) and Jayqaun Mincey (O8). Detective Richardson asked Deputy Jeffries about the style of shoes being worn by the vehicle occupants. Deputy Jeffries took photographs of the shoes and soles Joshua and Jayqaun were wearing during the stop. Detective Richardson noted Joshua was wearing all white Nike Air Force One's. Detective Richardson recalled a photo of a fresh shoe impression taken by the responding deputy outside of Terri's silver Ford SUV covered by broken glass at the Vann Park scene during the initial investigation. Based on the digital photographs Detective Richardson determined the shoe impression and the photographed sole of Joshua's shoe soles were the same pattern. Deputy Jeffries advised Joshua did not possess a valid driver's license, he was being arrested, and transported to the Hardee County Jail. Deputy Jeffries said Joshua's cell phone was also found inside the vehicle and left in place. Deputy Jeffries said Joshua confirmed to him that was his (Joshua's) cell phone in the vehicle. Detective Richardson requested Deputy Jeffries seal and tow to a secured facility while a Search Warrant could be obtained to retrieve Joshua's cell phone and other potential evidence related to the crimes within Volusia County. Detective Richardson uploaded the photographs provided by Deputy Jeffries to Axon Evidence.

On March 6, Detective Richardson received video surveillance footage from the Deltona Parks and Recreation department of video of Vann Park on March 2, 2024. The video titled "Club House Outfield 1" showed the silver Nissan passenger car with dark tinted windows and same wheels seen on the license plate reader in Deltona and video footage from Dewey Boster Park, enter the park and drive toward the rear parking lot at 10:30 timestamp of the video and exit the camera's view. At the 10:31:40 timestamp, the video shows the silver Nissan re-enter the camera view driving to the clubhouse parking lot and parking next to the passenger side of Jacqueline's gray Ford SUV closest to the clubhouse. At the 10:34:12 timestamp, the driver's door and rear passenger door behind the driver both open and the subject from the driver's seat wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt can be seen ducking between the two vehicles concealed between the Nissan's doors. The subject gains entry into Jacqueline's gray Ford via the unlocked passenger door and can be seen rummaging through the SUV. After the subject exits the gray SUV at the 10:34:51 timestamp, the subject gets into the driver's seat of the silver Nissan and drives backward in the parking lot, and it appears the silver Nissan is also occupied by an unknown person in the front passenger seat. The silver Nissan then parks at an angle behind a small silver passenger car at the 10:35:27 timestamp when the driver exits the silver Nissan. The driver's face and upper body are captured for a very brief moment, and it shows the driver is a black male wearing a white t-shirt under the black hooded sweatshirt with the hood over his head. The driver again ducks between parked vehicles and approaches the passenger side of a red passenger car, appears to look into the vehicle from the outside, and attempt to enter the vehicle by pulling on the door handles. At the 10:35:51 timestamp, the subject abandons his efforts to enter the red vehicle and returns to the driver's seat of the silver Nissan again reversing in the parking lot. At the 10:36:04 timestamp, the silver Nissan parks perpendicular behind Terri's silver Ford SUV, the driver exits the silver Nissan, crouches down, and approaches the front passenger door of Terri's vehicle. At the 10:36:10 timestamp, the subject can be seen looking into the rear and front passenger compartment windows of Terri's vehicle. It appears the subject attempts to enter the front passenger door but is unsuccessful. The subject returns to the silver Nissan to retrieve an unknown item, reapproaches the rear passenger door of Terri's vehicle, and breaks the window. There is a slight lag in the video, but it can clearly be seen that the rear passenger window of Terri's vehicle is fully intact and then obviously broken at the 10:36:32 timestamp as the subject is seen entering the driver's seat of the silver Nissan car. The silver Nissan quickly leaves the park traveling West on Elgrove Drive toward Whitewood Drive at the 10:36:47 timestamp. A different camera inside Vann Park labeled "Entrance" captures the Florida license plate PI101R attached to the silver Nissan as it enters Vann Park and drives toward the rear lot.

Based on the timeline of events captured on video surveillance footage at both parks and the residential camera outside of Vann Park, Detective Richardson determined after leaving Vann Park the silver Nissan travels to Dewey Boster Park and commits more vehicle burglaries. Per Google Maps the distance between the two parks is approximately 2.6 miles or a 7-minute drive. This timeframe directly matches the time the silver Nissan is captured on camera entering Dewey Boster Park at 1043 hours. The approximate distance from Dewey Boster Park to Interstate 4 via Saxon Blvd is 2.5 miles or a 6 to 8-minute drive. Again, this timeline matches up with the timeframe the Nissan is seen leaving Dewey Boster Park at 10:58:29 hours and is last captured on camera in Volusia County near Interstate 4 bearing the stolen Florida tag PI101R.

On March 7, 2024, Detective Richardson received and reviewed a crime bulletin regarding vehicle burglaries in Lake Mary, Florida which occurred on March 2, 2024. The bulletin indicated that multiple vehicle burglaries took place at the Lake Mary Sports Complex and were reported under case number 202470000134. The suspect vehicle was listed as a silver Nissan passenger car with dark tinted windows bearing Florida tag: EVY127, registered to Sixt Rent A Car LLC. Detective Richardson determined this was the exact vehicle responsible for the vehicle burglaries in Volusia County.

Detective Richardson submitted a formal request to Sixt Rent A Car LLC via email regarding the renter information of the silver Nissan bearing Florida tag: EVY127 and VIN 1N4BL4DV0RN352000 between February 26 and March 5, 2024.

Due to the vehicle being held in secure storage within the jurisdiction of the Hardee County Sheriff's Office, Detective Richardson is requesting a Search Warrant to obtain evidence contained within the 2024 silver Nissan Altima bearing Florida tag: EVY127 and VIN 1N4BL4DV0RN352000, related to the crimes committed in Volusia County with the assistance of the Hardee County Sheriff's Office.

On March 8, 2024, Detective Richardson received the requested renter information from Sixt Rent A Car LLC. The silver Nissan bearing Florida tag: EVY127 was rented on February 24, 2024, by Ashaunti Sears (FL [REDACTED] (O9) at the International Drive location in Orlando. The renter information documentation was uploaded to Axon Evidence.

Detective Richardson found an address for Ashaunti using the online DAVID database listed as 7422 Sigma Court, Orlando.

Detective Richardson and Sergeant Johnson responded to Ashaunti's address, but no one answered the door. Detectives met with the property manager of the apartment complex who verified Ashaunti was the lease holder of that residence. The property manager provided a phone number of 407-413-0824 for Ashaunti.

Sergeant Johnson called Ashaunti who stated she used her driver's license and credit card to rent the silver Nissan for her friend "Dora" from Sixt Rent A Car. Ashaunti advised she has not been in possession of the rental vehicle after she gave the car to Dora on the day she rented it (February 24). Ashaunti later identified Dora as Cyntoria White (O10) with an address of 7 Dorcas Court in Orlando. Ashaunti said she has been trying to get in touch with Cyntoria about the rental vehicle because Sixt Rent A Car has been emailing her (Ashaunti) informing her the vehicle was not returned on the return date of March 2, 2024, and there is an outstanding balance for the rental. Ashaunti stated Cyntoria has not responded to Ashaunti's calls or messages. Sergeant Johnson told Ashaunti the rental vehicle was being held in law enforcement custody due to its recent involvements in multiple vehicle burglaries. Sergeant Johnson also explained Joshua Hansen was driving the vehicle and accompanied by Jayqaun Mincey when the vehicle was stopped by the Hardee County Sheriff's Office. Ashaunti said she knows Joshua and he is Cyntoria's boyfriend. Ashaunti's recorded statement was uploaded to Axon Evidence.

The Hardee County Sheriff's Office Investigations Division assisted Detective Richardson with obtaining a Search Warrant for the silver Nissan bearing Florida tag: EVY127 and VIN 1N4BL4DV0RN352000, which was signed by the Honorable Judge J. Flynn in Hardee County on March 8, 2024.

On March 11, 2024, Detective Richardson and Detective Mefford met with Deputy Jeffries from the Hardee County Sheriff's Office and executed the Search Warrant.

The silver Nissan bearing Florida tag: EVY127, which was secured by the Hardee County Sheriff's Office inside a chain link fence with barbed wire surrounding the top of the fence and secured with a lock and chain. Upon inspecting the vehicle, Detective Richardson noticed the right rear passenger window had been broken and pushed in and there were two strike marks on the front right passenger window which appeared to have been made by a window punch. The front passenger window was broken but did not allow access to the vehicle. The Hardee County Sheriff's Office is investigating the incident. Inside the vehicle, Detective Richardson located the below listed items:

- Touch DNA swabs from the Nissan's steering wheel
- 2 dark blue Apple iPhones (one in the driver's door pocket and the other under the driver's seat)
- 1 small black window punch in the driver's door handle
- 1 pair of white Nike Air Force One's on the driver's seat
- 1 black knit glove inside the center center console
- 1 screwdriver with a black handle inside the glove compartment
- 1 black Nike hooded jacket from the rear passenger seat behind the driver's seat

Deputy Jeffries and the Hardee County Sheriff's Office released the above listed property in Detective Richardson's custody. Detective Richardson submitted the property into Evidence via the Volusia Sheriff's Office District 4 Lockers.

Detective Richardson also uploaded photocopies of the Hardee County Sheriff's Office search warrant and property report into Axon Evidence.

Several photographs of the Nissan were taken and uploaded to Axon Evidence. Detective Richardson inspected the license plate area of the vehicle specifically where the screws are placed to attach the license plate to the vehicle. Detective Richardson noted it appeared the license plate screws have been inserted and removed multiple times based on the amount of "damage" seen on this newer model vehicle.

Furthermore, Detective Richardson believes a tower dump search warrant using Joshua's cell phone number (954-338-0024) registered to him which was found using an online investigative resource would become highly evidentiary in the prosecution of this case. This information should prove or exclude Joshua's phone was in the City of Deltona during the vehicle burglaries on March 2, 2024.

On March 13, 2024, Detective Richardson reviewed the FUSUS traffic cameras in Seminole County in the area where the silver Nissan bearing Florida tag EVY127 was captured on license plate readers prior to being seen entering Volusia County on March 2, 2024. The silver Nissan was seen traveling southbound on Country Club Road toward Lake Mary Blvd then turning right onto Lake Mary Blvd at approximately 0850 hours. The silver Nissan was again seen traveling South on Country Club Road and crossing Lake Mary Blvd at approximately 0917 hours. These are consistent with the photos from the license plate readers in the immediate area capturing the silver Nissan. There is also a FUSUS traffic camera at the intersection of Lake Mary Blvd and Sir Lawrence Drive which is approximately 323 feet (line of sight) from 211 Rosecliff Circle where the Carl Black of Orlando dealer tag (PI101R) was reported stolen. The silver Nissan was captured on the Sir Lawrence Drive FUSUS camera traveling toward Rosecliff Circle on March 2, 2024, at approximately 0922 hours. Based on this information Detective Richardson determined the timeline for the dealer tag (PI101R) to be stolen off the black GMC pickup




truck on Rosecliff Circle, it to be placed on the silver Nissan, the silver Nissan travel to Volusia County via Interstate 4 and commit the vehicle burglaries at the parks was consistent with the license plate reader data.

In conclusion, based on the multiple surveillance footage videos capturing the silver Nissan in the parks on March 2, 2024, between 1030 and 1100 hours which directly correlates to when the vehicle burglaries occurred. This information coupled with the same silver Nissan being seen on the same date, at an intersection (Sir Lawrence Drive and W Lake Mary Blvd) in Lake Mary approximately 173 feet from the parking lot where the tag (PI101R) was reported stolen off the black GMC pickup truck. The time the silver Nissan was seen at the intersection was approximately one hour prior to it being captured on a license plate reader entering the City of Deltona bearing the stolen Florida tag: PI101R and again in Dewey Boster and Vann Parks with the same stolen tag. Additionally, the sole pattern of the driver's (Joshua Hansen) shoes he was wearing when the vehicle was stopped in Hardee County on March 5, 2024, matched the sole pattern seen directly next to and just outside Terri Ellis' silver Ford SUV at Vann Park. The sole prints were compared via photographs taken while on scene during the initial investigation and the driver's shoe soles during the traffic stop in Hardee County, the photo from the scene showed the fresh shoe print had broken glass from the victim's broken window on top of it consistent with the vehicle burglaries. Furthermore, the evidence collected from the silver Nissan during the execution of the Search Warrant: the black Nike hooded jacket, white Nike shoes, small black window punch in the driver's door handle, black knit glove, and the screwdriver inside the glove compartment also indicate Joshua was the individual seen burglarizing the vehicles using a window punch inside Vann Park in Deltona on March 2, 2024. Also, while searching the silver Nissan all the clothing observed inside the car and stored inside a black duffel bag appeared to be a male's clothing.

Detective Richardson determined sufficient probable cause existed to charge Josua Hansen with six counts of Unoccupied Burglary of an Unoccupied Conveyance, one count of Grand Theft \$750 less than \$5,000, four counts of Petit Theft, and five counts of Criminal Mischief \$200 or more under \$1,000. Detective Richardson forwarded the signed charging affidavit to the State Attorney's Office for review.
